Please take note of our after school guidelines:

1. **Fees will not be pro-rated.** No refunds can be made after the first class. No refunds can be made for cancellation or reassignment due to inclement weather.
2. You will be notified by phone if an activity is filled or dropped and your payment will be refunded.
3. Students must bring their own nut-free after school snack.
4. After-school programs are for everyone's enjoyment. If there is a problem with misbehavior and we have given a telephone warning, we reserve the right to dismiss a disruptive student from the class and from the program. In this event, parents will be contacted immediately and program fees will be forfeited.
5. Some classes have enrollment limits. Classes will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis. We cannot guarantee placement in classes after the registration period is closed.
6. **Students will be permitted to enroll in and attend classes only after checks have been received. Additionally, students will only be allowed to enroll in the winter after school session if their winter after school accounts have been settled.**
